




**Vehicle maintenance contributes to safety.**

When we drive a vehicle we assume responsibilities with the traffic, other road users, with ourselves and with the vehicle itself.

With preventive maintenance of the vehicle, such as oil change, lubrication, adjustments, cleaning, repairs, parts replacement, tire maintenance, among others, we promote safety while driving.

By checking and maintaining the vehicle frequently, we can...

- **Prevent costly repairs.** Continuing to drive with some malfunctions can lead to subsequent wear and tear making repair more expensive and may even be detrimental to safety.
- If the vehicle has proper and periodic maintenance **fuel efficiency will increase.** When you don't change oil and filters when necessary, there will be an increase in fuel consumption, coupled with engine wear.



- **Changing tires** and keeping them in good condition not only contributes to reducing fuel consumption, but also to safety while driving. They are the contact between the vehicle and the road, they transmit traction, and they allow us to stop the vehicle, accelerate and turn.
- And, without a doubt, a vehicle in good condition will make **your trip more reliable, calmer and safer**. That will help you drive with less concerns and more relaxed.
- With a vehicle in good condition, chances of suffering **mishaps along the way** are reduced, which has a direct impact on the safety of both you and other road users. Stopping on the way, obstructing free circulation is always a risk.
- Periodically check the vehicle's maintenance manual or book, in it there are detailed tasks that have to be performed every number of kilometers traveled in order to keep it in perfect working order.
