

# **VEHICLE MAINTENANCE**


Proper vehicle maintenance is associated with durability, safety, economy, and environmental protection.





## **Checking tire pressure**


- Check tire pressure once a week, as indicated in the owner's manual and according to load conditions you normally transport.
- Inflation pressure must be checked when tires are cold (after driving no more than 2 km).
- Remember to check your spare tire too.





#### Tire treads


- Check tire tread depth. Although the legal limit is 1.6 mm, a depth of at least 2.0 mm is recommended.
- Have your tires rotated every 10,000 km or before, if necessary. Refer to the owner's manual and/or consult an auto maintenance technician.
- Have the wheels balanced and aligned every 10,000 km. Refer to the owner's manual and/or consult an auto maintenance technician.





#### **Checking engine oil level**

- Pull the dipstick to read oil level, which should be between the minimum and maximum marks.
- Oil-change frequency depends on the type of oil used. Refer to the owner's manual and/or consult an auto maintenance technician.
- In case you are adding oil, do not overfill.






#### **Checking coolant level**

Before checking coolant level, the engine must be cold. Coolant level should be situated between the minimum and maximum marks.

- Coolant must be inspected and replaced once a year.
- Some vehicles use a special type of coolant.
  Refer to the owner's manual and/or consult an auto maintenance technician.





## **Checking brake fluid level**

- Brake fluid level must be inspected once a year by a service technician.
- Check fluid level. If it is below the minimum mark, there may be a leak in the system. In this case, consult an auto maintenance technician immediately.





## **Checking filters**

- Air filter must be inspected twice a year.
- Oil filter must be replaced every other oil change. Always refer to the owner's manual and/or consult an auto maintenance technician.
- Fuel filter must be replaced once a year. Refer to the owner's manual.





#### **Checking windshield and lights**

- Check windshield washer fluid level.
- Check windshield wiper blades. If the rubber is in bad shape, replace wipers to avoid damaging the windshield and restricting vision.
- Check headlights and tail lights regularly.





## **Checking belts**

#### **Timing belt**

 Replacement frequency varies according to mileage and belt age as well as vehicle make and model. Refer to the owner's manual.

#### Serpentine belt

 The alternator recharges the battery when the engine is running. Replacement frequency will depend on vehicle make and model. Refer to the owner's manual.
